Purchase Order - Environmental Terms and Conditions (ISO 14001)

1. Environmental Compliance

The Supplier shall comply with all applicable federal, state, provincial, and local environmental laws, regulations, permits, and other legal requirements applicable to the products and services provided under this Purchase Order.

2. Environmental Management

The Supplier shall maintain processes that minimize adverse environmental impacts associated with its operations. Suppliers maintaining an environmental management system certified to ISO 14001 are encouraged to maintain such certification throughout the duration of the business relationship.

3. Hazardous Materials

The Supplier shall disclose the presence of any hazardous substances contained within the products supplied and shall provide current Safety Data Sheets (SDS) where required. Products shall comply with all applicable chemical and environmental regulations.

4. Waste Management

The Supplier shall manage, store, transport, recycle, and dispose of waste materials generated during the manufacture or delivery of products in accordance with all applicable environmental regulations.

5. Spill Prevention and Pollution Control

The Supplier shall implement reasonable measures to prevent spills, releases, emissions, and other forms of pollution that could negatively impact the environment.

6. Packaging

Suppliers are encouraged to utilize recyclable, reusable, or reduced packaging whenever practical while ensuring adequate protection of the product during shipment.

7. Environmental Incident Notification

The Supplier shall promptly notify the Purchaser of any environmental incident, regulatory action, or compliance issue that could affect the manufacture, quality, delivery, or environmental compliance of the products or services supplied.

8. Subcontractors

The Supplier shall ensure that subcontractors involved in fulfilling this Purchase Order comply with environmental requirements equivalent to those contained herein.

9. Right to Assess

Upon reasonable notice, the Purchaser reserves the right to request documentation demonstrating compliance with applicable environmental requirements and, when appropriate, conduct supplier assessments or audits related to environmental performance.

10. Continuous Improvement

The Supplier is encouraged to continually improve environmental performance through pollution prevention, waste reduction, resource conservation, recycling, and energy efficiency initiatives.

11. Nonconformance

Failure to comply with applicable environmental requirements may constitute a material breach of this Purchase Order and may result in corrective action requests, suspension of new business, or termination of the business relationship.

12. Flow-Down Requirement

The Supplier shall communicate applicable environmental requirements to its own suppliers and subcontractors involved in the manufacture or provision of products and services supplied under this Purchase Order.

13. Record Retention

Environmental records required to demonstrate compliance with applicable regulations or contractual requirements shall be retained for a minimum of three (3) years unless otherwise specified by applicable law or contractual agreement and shall be made available upon reasonable request.
